Thank you for attending the recent Board Meeting of the European Suzuki Association (ESA) in Brussels, Belgium and submitting an application from *The Suzuki Music Method "Talent Education" Development Association of Citizens and Organizations* (Russian Suzuki Association) for Full Country Membership of the ESA.
